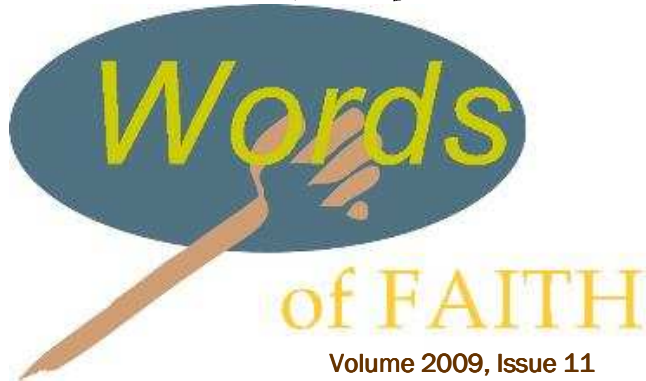


# November

The Vision Team at Faith is in the planning stages of making a commitment to be in ministry to a neighborhood in Canal Winchester which has a higher density of families with low incomes (say an apartment complex).

We would rent an apartment and do many of our regular ministries at that site, plus some new ones, in order to build relationships with people in the neighborhood.

We could do:

- Tools for Schools for the kids in the neighborhood
- A-adopt a family for a few families in the neighborhood
- a weekly meal
- after school tutoring, or drive them to Educare for the afterschool program
- Sponsor/coach a team from the neighborhood in the CW recreation league, or one of the Upward basketball leagues.
- Take the kids to summer camp
- Youth group with the kids in the neighborhood.
- Offer to help families with their taxes.
- A health screening.
- a weekly bible study for adults
- Teach a parenting class
- and more!!!

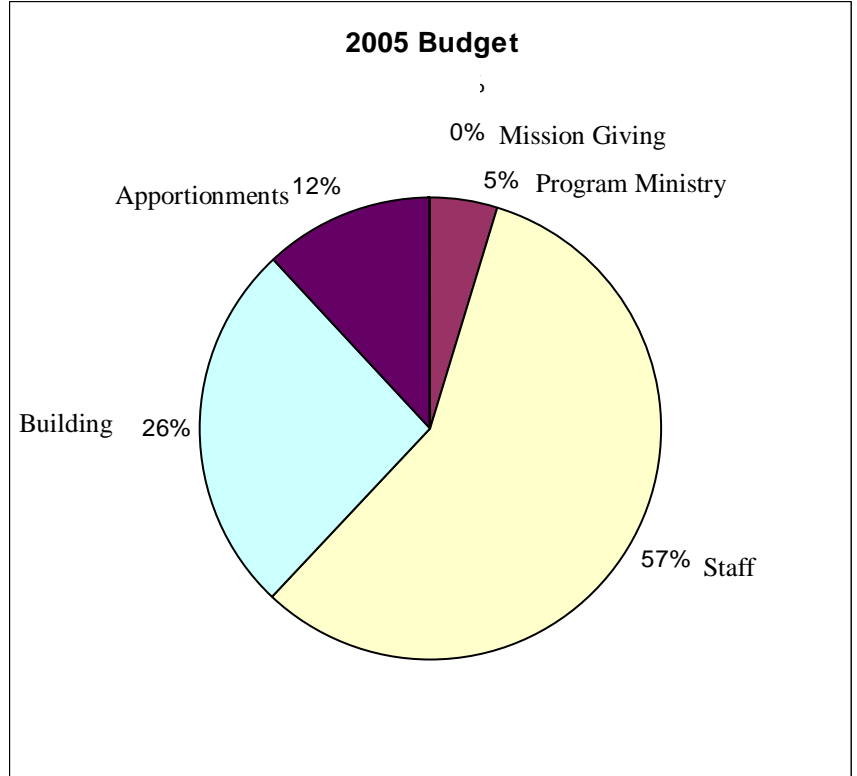

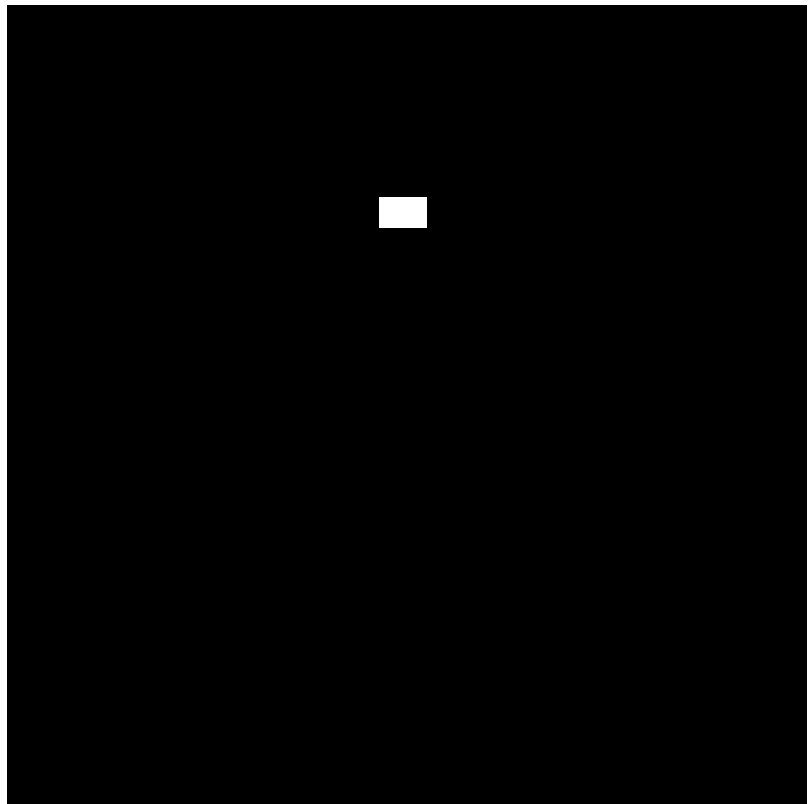
**Our target budget** has 10% in mission giving, and a balance between mission giving and internal program ministry.

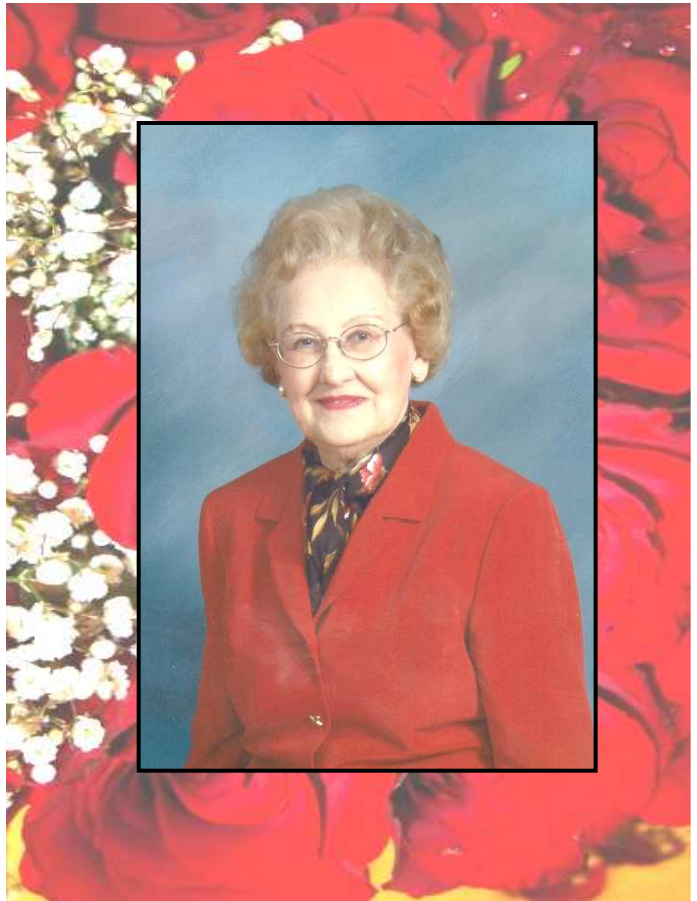

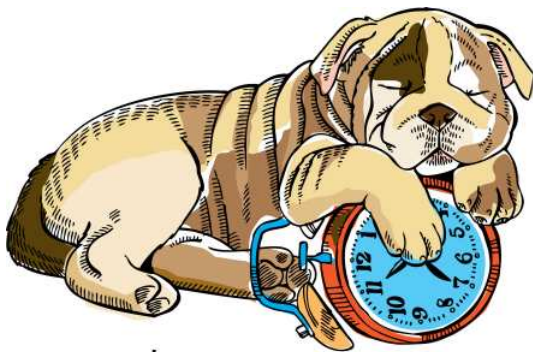

## BLANKET SUNDAY November 8

For a donation of five dollars each you can provide a blanket to people in crisis across the world. After a hurricane, tsunami, flood, or draught, your love can be felt in a practical and tangible way. Nothing is more comforting than a warm blanket after your life has been shattered.

The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) partners with Church World Service to purchase and ship blankets worldwide and within the U.S. They support a variety of self-help development projects through its partner agencies. Because UMCOR buys in large quantities, it can provide a good wool or cotton blend blanket for a modest \$5. When possible, blankets are purchased closer to the scene of a disaster, to speed delivery and to spur local economies.

**Our goal this year is to provide for 100 blankets and tools.** Each week we average 100 people in worship so this just one blanket per person. Your participation is needed to reach the goal.
